Intent

To provide clear and concise guidelines for the administration of the payment of a rebate to residents within the Rockhampton Regional Council area when purchasing various water efficient products.

PROVISIONS

Eligibility

1. Owners of property and tenants registered at the tenancy address on the Rockhampton Regional Council electoral roll and who have purchased and installed eligible water saving products after 1 July 2008.
2. Eligible customers, in accordance with clause 1, can claim only one of each rebate type for each eligible property. The products offered include Shower Heads, Dual Flush Toilets, Rainwater Tanks and Washing Machines.
3. Rebate is for retrofit of water efficient devices in residential premises only (with the exception of new washing machines that would otherwise be eligible).
4. To claim a rebate, the relevant application form must be completed and mailed/delivered to Rockhampton Regional Council together with the appropriate supporting information.
5. To qualify for the rebates, applications must be accompanied by the following supporting information:
 - a. Product specification; and
 - b. Photocopy of receipts (*receipt name and address must match name and address on this application form*)

Rebate Items

6. Rainwater Tanks: The rainwater tank rebate is conditional upon tanks meeting the following installation requirements:
 - 6.1 Minimum tank size 5,000L
 - 6.2 Colour, shape and position of tank/s will be assessed on a case by case basis with due regard to neighbourhood amenity.
 - 6.3 Installation shall include screening to exclude leaves, insects and other debris.
 - 6.4 A minimum of 20 litres of the first flush of roof catchment rainwater diverted/discarded before entering the rainwater tank where:
 - (a) connected to showers, wash basins, kitchen or hot water services.
 - 6.5 Installations will have two categories.
 - (a) Stand alone tank with outside use only.
 - (b) Integrated systems shall also incorporate mains supply top-up (where available) with connection to at least two of toilet, hot water, and washing machine internal fixtures in addition to mandatory garden use. Potable use such as kitchen sink, bathroom basin or bath/shower may also be connected but are not mandatory.
 - 6.6 The tanks must be installed in accordance with adopted guidelines and by a licensed plumber if required by the *Public Health Regulations 2005*. The installation must also meet any relevant building code or plumbing and drainage code requirements and have the necessary Council permit where required. Rainwater tanks subject to rebate must be used for the collection and storage of rainwater.
 - 6.7 An inspection of the installed tank may need to be conducted by Council prior to payment of rebate.
 - 6.8 The available rebates for the two categories are:
 - (a) \$250.00 for stand alone tanks
 - (b) \$500.00 for integrated systems
 - 6.9 Rain water tanks installed at new premises are not eligible for the rebate.
7. Toilets: To receive the \$50 rebate on a dual-flush toilet (cistern and pan) the new toilet must be a 6/3 litre or 4.5/3 litre system and replace an existing toilet system. Toilets installed in new properties are not eligible for the rebate. To be eligible for this rebate the new toilet must be installed by a licensed plumber, must meet any relevant plumbing and drainage codes and have the necessary Council permit where required.
8. Shower Roses: To receive the \$25 rebate for a shower rose, the product installed must be at least 'AAA' rated and use 9 litres or less water per minute.
9. Washing Machines: To receive the \$100.00 rebate, the washing machine must have a WELS rating of at least four stars. Intending applicants are encouraged to seek confirmation of eligibility prior to purchase, however this is not obligatory.

General

10. Delivery and installation charges can be included as part of the total purchase price.
11. Rebate recipients consent to, and recognise that, Rockhampton Regional Council may contact them to conduct research about the conservation products purchased.
12. Rebates will be processed as a direct debit in accordance with the details provided on the application form.
13. Applicants must repay any Rebates provided if any of these terms and conditions is found to have been breached.
14. The Rockhampton Regional Council reserves the right, at its sole discretion and at any time, to change any or all of the Terms and Conditions for the Rebate Scheme or to cancel the Rebate Scheme.
15. The applicant(s) acknowledges and agrees that as far as the law permits, Rockhampton Regional Council accepts no liability in respect of any claim, cause of action or loss or damage arising out of or in relation to, any rain water tank system, the consumption of any water from such rainwater system or other conservation products subject to this rebate scheme. The applicant(s) agree that they will indemnify and keep indemnified Rockhampton Regional Council from any claim or liability arising out of or in relation to any rainwater tank system, the consumption of any water from such rainwater tank system or other conservation products subject to this rebate scheme and application to the extent that any claim or liability is not caused by Rockhampton Regional Council negligence or breach of this application or any other term implied by law.
16. In accordance with Privacy legislation the information collected here will be used to process applications for rebates on the purchase of water conservation products. Information provided on the application form may be used to measure and monitor the success of this Scheme.

This policy is to remain in force until otherwise determined by Council.
